- Hosting health and wellness demonstrations, workshops and community fairs that provide actionable information to enable community members to make healthier choices and lead healthier lives.
- Creating healthy meal kits that provide children and families with opportunities to cook and try new healthy foods.
- Collecting healthy food, books, cooking utensils, sporting goods and other supplies for families in need.
